



Activity Consent Form – Year 6 Drama Lessons

18 June 2021

Dear Parent/Carer

On **Monday 19 July 2021**, all Year 6 students we will be commencing **drama lessons** as part of the **Semester 2 Drama Unit 'Natural Disasters'**.

The aim of the drama lessons is for students to devise, rehearse, perform and respond to scripted drama that develops a narrative exploring the impact of a natural disaster on communities.

Each student will be assessed on the drama component of the Arts curriculum. The dramas will also support students in the development of their science knowledge in Term 3 when they will be investigating how natural events cause rapid changes to the Earth's surface.

Activity details:

Classes will commence, during school time, on **Monday 19 July 2021** (Term 3 Week 2) and continue on a weekly basis for 8 weeks (excluding 9th August Exhibition Show Holiday). Each lesson will be held in the Kurwongbah State School hall for 40 minutes per week. The lessons will be conducted by professional drama teachers from **Creative Dance Industries**. Class teachers will also be supervising lessons and assessing the final performance and reflection.

During the 8 lessons students will:

- ❖ explore dramatic action, empathy and space in improvisations, play- building and scripted drama to develop characters and situations in response to natural disaster stimulus
- ❖ develop skills and techniques of voice and movement to create character, mood and atmosphere, and focus dramatic action
- ❖ rehearse and perform devised and scripted drama that develops narrative, drives dramatic tension, and uses dramatic symbol, performance styles and design elements to share a narrative about the impact of natural disasters on a community
- ❖ explain and compare how the elements of drama and production elements communicate meaning in drama about the impact of natural disasters in different communities

Students should wear their school uniform and suitable shoes for drama lessons.

Activity costs: \$16.00 in total per child for 8 lessons.

Payment due: Monday 26 July 2021

Kurwongbah State School is a cashless school. Preferred payment method is BPOINT (using the BPOINT link on the invoice emailed to you). Payment can also be made by QParents, EFTPOS or Cheque/Money Order (payable to Kurwongbah State School). **Payment must be made by Monday 26 July 2021. No late payments can be accepted.**

Refund guidelines for activities:

At Kurwongbah State School we are committed to providing a safe and supportive learning environment for students, staff and volunteers. This commitment includes the health and safety of staff and students when conducting curriculum activities in the school or in other locations.

School excursions and camps enhance a student's learning by providing opportunities for the student to participate in activities, both curriculum-related and recreational, outside the normal school routine. All planned school excursions are approved by the Principal and endorsed by the Parents and Citizens Association.

State schools are able to charge a fee for:

- An educational service including materials and consumables not defined as instruction, administration and facilities for the education of the student;
- An education service purchased from a provider other than the school where the provider charges the school; and

- A specialised educational program.

A school fee is directed to the purpose for which it is charged.

School fees for excursions and camps are calculated on a cost recovery only basis, according to the number of students who have indicated their attendance.

Participation of students in an excursion or camp is indicated through payment of the excursion or camp fee and provision of a permission form completed by the parent/carer.

As the school budget cannot meet any shortfalls in funding for an excursion or camp due to the subsequent non-participation of a student who had previously indicated attendance of the activity, fees already paid for an excursion or school camp may be refunded in full or in part or not at all, having regard to the associated expenses incurred and the circumstances of the non-participation.

If a parent/carer wishes to apply for a refund due to their child's non-participation in an excursion or camp activity, they may do so by completing a Request for Refund form available from the school office. Where possible, the request should include the receipt relating to the payment for which a refund is being sought.

Privacy notice
