



Activity consent form – Year 6 Aussie World Excursion

Privacy Statement

The Department of Education is collecting the personal information in this form in order to:

- obtain consent for the named child/student to participate in the named off-site activity;
- help coordinate the off-site activity;
- respond to any injury or medical condition that may arise during or as a result of the off-site activity; and
- update school records where necessary.

The information will only be accessed by authorised departmental staff. The information will not be disclosed to any other person or agency unless we have your consent or we are required or authorised by law to do so e.g. in compliance with relevant [Queensland Chief Health Officer's Directions](#).

On Tuesday 7th December 2021 we will be visiting Aussie World (the activity) as part of our Year 6 Graduation celebrations.

Activity details:

- Students will depart at approximately 8:30am and return at approximately 4:30pm
- We will be visiting 'Aussie World' (just off the Bruce Highway at Palmview, Sunshine Coast)
- Students will have a choice of a range of activities throughout the site. More details can be found on the website : www.aussieworld.com.au
- Students do not need to wear school uniform on the day but need to have a shirt with sleeves, closed in shoes and wear their school hat. It is essential that students bring a drink bottle with them.
- There are a series of activities students can access where they will get wet. If your child is likely to access these activities then they will need to wear swimmers and bring a towel and bag to store wet clothing. All students must wear a sun-safe shirt if participating in wet activities.
- Lunch can be purchased at Aussie World for an additional cost (see menu for food choices and prices : https://www.aussieworld.com.au/images/AUSSIEWORLD_CAFE_MENU.pdf). Students can also bring their own lunch which will be stored with our school equipment on site.
- All Year 6 teachers and some additional support staff will be in attendance. Students will form groups of up to 10 students and will be allocated to a teacher whilst on site. 11 x Kurwongbah Staff members will attend with students on this excursion.
- Students will travel by a seat-belt equipped Kangaroo Bus Lines Coach.
- Our Student Code of Conduct applies to all of our students whilst on school property and off site. Students who have breached school expectations prior to this excursion may be ineligible to participate.

Activity costs: \$35.00. Students with outstanding payments linked to Year 6 Camp in Term 1 will be unable to attend unless all outstanding fees are settled prior to 19th November.

Kurwongbah State School is a cashless school. Preferred payment method is BPOINT (using the BPOINT link on the invoice emailed to you). Payment can also be made by QParents, EFTPOS or Cheque/Money Order (payable to Kurwongbah State School). **Payment must be made by Friday 19th November. This is a firm date and no late payments will be accepted.**

Refund Guidelines for Activities:

At Kurwongbah State School we are committed to providing a safe and supportive learning environment for students, staff and volunteers. This commitment includes the health and safety of staff and students when conducting curriculum activities in the school or in other locations.

School excursions and camps enhance a student's learning by providing opportunities for the student to participate in activities, both curriculum-related and recreational, outside the normal school routine. All planned school excursions are approved by the Principal and endorsed by the Parents and Citizens Association.

State schools are able to charge a fee for:

- An educational service including materials and consumables not defined as instruction, administration and facilities for the education of the student;
- An education service purchased from a provider other than the school where the provider charges the school; and
- A specialised educational program.

A school fee is directed to the purpose for which it is charged.

School fees for excursions and camps are calculated on a cost recovery only basis, according to the number of students who have indicated their attendance.

Participation of students in an excursion or camp is indicated through payment of the excursion or camp fee and provision of a permission form completed by the parent/carer.


