



Activity consent form – Year 3-6 Swimming Carnival

Privacy Statement

The Department of Education is collecting the personal information in this form in order to:

- obtain consent for the named child/student to participate in the named off-site activity;
- help coordinate the off-site activity;
- respond to any injury or medical condition that may arise during or as a result of the off-site activity; and
- update school records where necessary.

The information will only be accessed by authorised departmental staff. The information will not be disclosed to any other person or agency unless we have your consent or we are required or authorised by law to do so e.g. in compliance with relevant [Queensland Chief Health Officer's Directions](#).

We encourage full participation at our Year 3-6 Swimming Carnival on Tuesday 30th November. We have a wide range of events that are scheduled that take into account the different abilities of students. These range from fun/ participation events (12.5m/ 25m and relay events) through to age group/ championship events. Students self-nominate on the day for 12.5m/ 25m or relay events but must have pre-nominated for the 50m championship events (this pre-nomination period ended 28/10/21). Students with limited confidence or limited swimming experience will be provided additional support to enable them to safely and confidently participate. Students are able to attend as spectators only if they prefer. All students must travel to and from the venue by bus. Students without signed parent permission to travel to and from the venue by bus as a participant or spectator will be supervised at school for the duration of the carnival.

On **Tuesday 30th November 2021**, we will be conducting the Year 3-6 Swimming Carnival as part of our Sports Program.

Activity details:

- Swimming Carnival to occur at Pine Rivers State High School pool.
- Students will travel to and from Pine Rivers State High School by bus. All students must have paid for the bus prior to the due date to be able to attend.
- Departure time for Kurwongbah State School is 9.30am.
- Students will return back to Kurwongbah State School by 2.45pm.
- A series of events are scheduled : 25m races (House Championship), Fun Relays (House Championship) and 50m races (Individual/ Age Championship/ District Trial Selection process).
- The inherent risk level of the activity is high. All mandatory staff: student supervision ratios are followed, students will be seated in a shaded grandstand or marshalling shed to avoid sun exposure. First Aid staff will be in attendance and modified activities/equipment will be available for students with less swimming experience .
- Students must wear approved swimwear (Speedo-type swimmers or boardshorts for boys/ one-piece or competition swimmers for girls). Students are to wear school shoes and their sports uniform at the carnival. Hats and sunscreen are essential items for all students.
- Students must have their own towel. They must also have swimming cap or hair ties in place to avoid hair entanglement.
- All students must bring adequate water to sustain them for the day. Lunch must also be taken by students as there is no Tuckshop access for our students.

Activity costs: \$4.00

Kurwongbah State School is a cashless school. Preferred payment method is BPOINT (using the BPOINT link on the invoice emailed to you). Payment can also be made by QParents, EFTPOS or Cheque/Money Order (payable to Kurwongbah State School). **Payment must be made by Friday 19th November 2021. No late payments can be accepted.**



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Refund Guidelines for Activities:

At Kurwongbah State School we are committed to providing a safe and supportive learning environment for students, staff and volunteers. This commitment includes the health and safety of staff and students when conducting curriculum activities in the school or in other locations.

School excursions and camps enhance a student's learning by providing opportunities for the student to participate in activities, both curriculum-related and recreational, outside the normal school routine. All planned school excursions are approved by the Principal and endorsed by the Parents and Citizens Association.

State schools are able to charge a fee for:

- An educational service including materials and consumables not defined as instruction, administration and facilities for the education of the student;
- An education service purchased from a provider other than the school where the provider charges the school; and
- A specialised educational program.

A school fee is directed to the purpose for which it is charged.

School fees for excursions and camps are calculated on a cost recovery only basis, according to the number of students who have indicated their attendance.

Participation of students in an excursion or camp is indicated through payment of the excursion or camp fee and provision of a permission form completed by the parent/carer.

As the school budget cannot meet any shortfalls in funding for an excursion or camp due to the subsequent non-participation of a student who had previously indicated attendance of the activity, fees already paid for an excursion or school camp may be refunded in full or in part or not at all, having regard to the associated expenses incurred and the circumstances of the non-participation.

If a parent/carer wishes to apply for a refund due to their child's non-participation in an excursion or camp activity, they may do so by completing a Request for Refund form available from the school office. Where possible, the request should include the receipt relating to the payment for which a refund is being sought.
