Dear Parent/Carer

On **Thursday 31st March 2022 (Term 1 Week 8)** we will be taking a virtual trip into space through the Star Lab Education dome, which will visit our school hall as a culminating activity to our Semester 1 Science Unit. **Each class will visit the Star Lab Dome from 8:50 am promptly for a one hour viewing of the show.**

The Year 1 program is based on the Australian curriculum demonstrating what is in the day and night sky. Students experience a simulation of sunrise, sunset, day and night to see stars, the moon and constellations. Students are taken on a virtual trip into space with a Full-dome show called 'TILT' to learn about the seasons and what causes them. Each student will be assessed on the science component of the science curriculum.

Activity details:

Exploring Sky and Land, students will attend an incursion in the school hall presented by Starlab Planetarium. The company provides a giant dome that simulates the night sky of our Southern Hemisphere. Inside, students can discover more about space and our solar system through the use of visual projections, demonstrations and multimedia. This is an interactive experience enabling the students to participate by asking questions and making observations about space. Please visit www.starlab.net.au for more information.

The incursion will commence during school time on Thursday 31st March 2022 (Term 1 Week 8) and each class will partake in the viewing which takes around 60 minutes per class.

Star Lab Education provides professional fully trained presenters that have consistently delivered quality educational programs since 2006. Class teachers will also be supervising lessons.

Students will:

- Observable changes occur in the sky & landscape.
- Recording short and longer-term patterns of events that occur on Earth and in the sky, such as the appearance of the moon and stars at night, the weather and the seasons.
- The impact of these changes on themselves and other living things.

Students should wear their school uniform and suitable shoes.

Activity costs: **\$10.00 per student**

Kurwongbah State School is a cashless school. Preferred payment method is BPOINT (using the BPOINT link on the invoice emailed to you). Payment can also be made by QParents, EFTPOS or Cheque/Money Order (payable to Kurwongbah State School). **Payment must be made by Monday 28th March 2022. No late payments can be accepted. Refund Guidelines for Activities:

At Kurwongbah State School we are committed to providing a safe and supportive learning environment for students, staff and volunteers. This commitment includes the health and safety of staff and students when conducting curriculum activities in the school or in other locations.

School excursions and camps enhance a student's learning by providing opportunities for the student to participate in activities, both curriculum-related and recreational, outside the normal school routine. All planned school excursions are approved by the Principal and endorsed by the Parents and Citizens Association.

State schools are able to charge a fee for:

If a parent/carer wishes to apply for a refund due to their child's non-participation in an excursion or camp activity, they may do so by completing a Request for Refund form available from the school office. Where possible, the request should include the receipt relating to the payment for which a refund is being sought.
