Redcliffe Hospital COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic

A dedicated COVID-19 vaccination clinic is starting at Redcliffe Hospital for those who identify as Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander – or are part of Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander families.

You don't need to book to get your vaccination.

Just visit our COVID-19 vaccination clinic anytime between 10am and 2:30pm on:

- Saturday 21 August
- Saturday 28 August
- Saturday 4 September
- Saturday 11 September
- Saturday 18 September
- Saturday 25 September

Our Indigenous Health Liaison Officers will be at the Vaccination Clinic on these days to help you and your family.

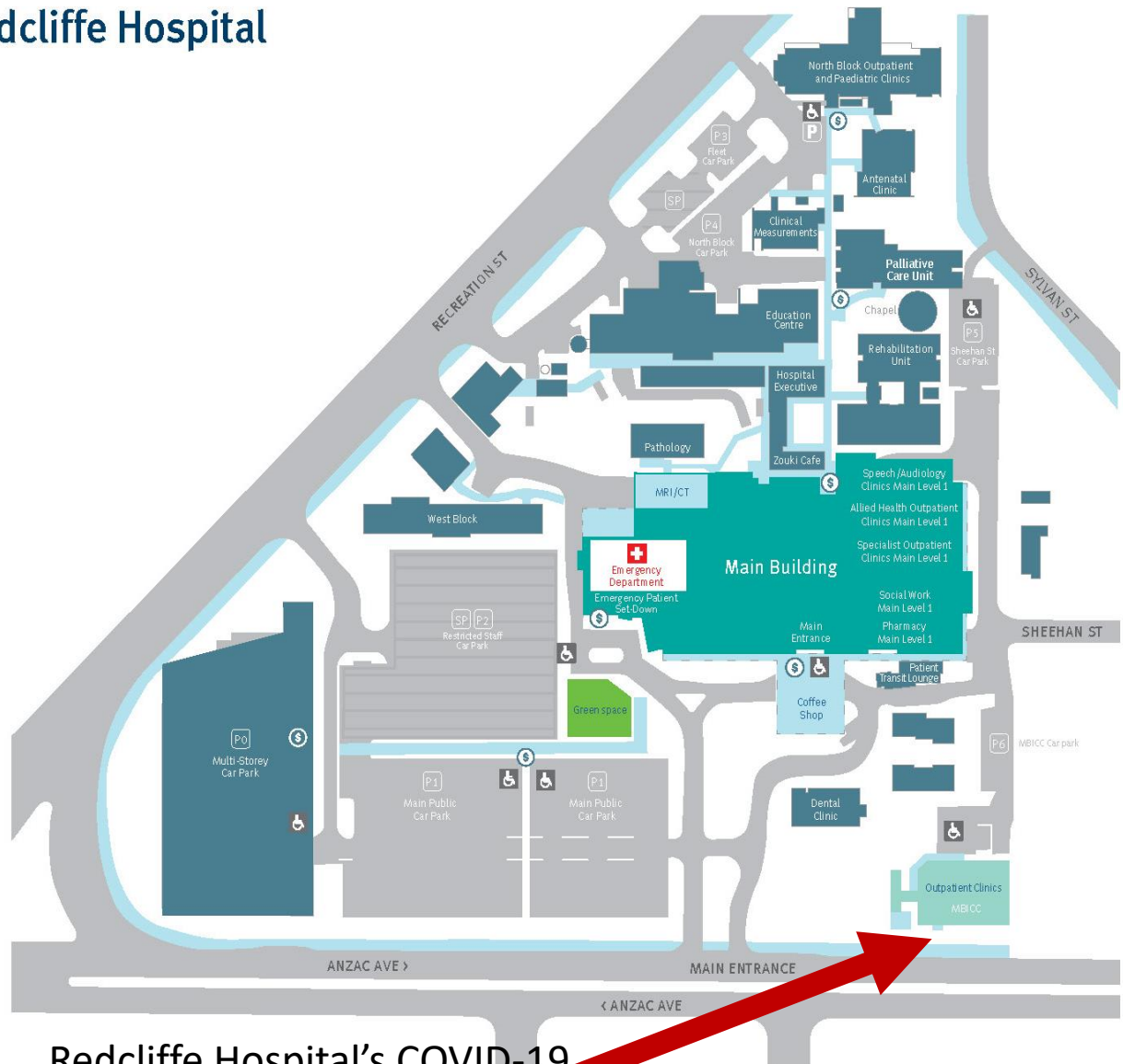
