Year 4	6 Key Learning Areas	To achieve an Academic Gold, students need to achieve 28 – 30 points
Silver Academic Award Criteria		
Year 3, 5 and 6	7 Key Learning Areas	To achieve an Academic Silver, students need to achieve 30 – 32 points
Year 4	6 Key Learning Areas	To achieve an Academic Silver, students need to achieve 25 – 27 points
