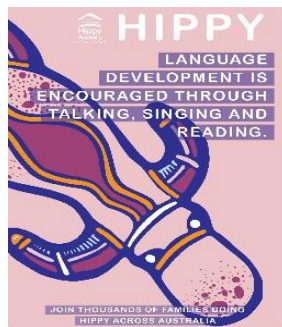

What is HIPPY?

Hippy stands for **Home Interaction Program for Parents and Youngsters**, HIPPY is a two-year at home play-based, early learning and parenting program that empowers you to be your child's first teacher which helps your child develop a love of learning. You will receive FREE resources, activity packs, storybooks, one-on-one support from a home mentor to assist you in actively playing while learning with your child.

What does HIPPY look like?

Hippy comprises of curriculum-based activity packs which your Hippy mentor will practice with you, then you complete the activities with your child. The activities support your child's learning in the following areas: **Thinking and Exploring, Communication, Creativity Social and Emotional, Family and Community**. We hold group gatherings, we offer FREE morning tea, kid's activities, parent's training, excursions for the family.

To enrol into HIPPY you must be:

- Living in the **Caboolture, Morayfield or Bellmere** area and
- Caring for a child that is 3 or turns 3 years of age before or on June 30th, 2023.
- Willing to commit to the program for 2 years and able to start by March 2023.

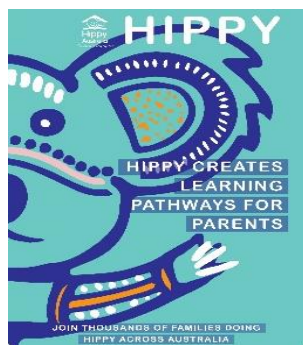
